REGIONAL (MP & WP)

Division Sizes

In 2025 the OCSL will operate the following divisions, each containing the following maximum number of teams:

Men's Premier	9 teams
Women's Premier	8 teams

SOSA is guaranteed one spot in the Premier division. They shall select the team to participate.

Number of Games

- MP: 16 games - WP: 14 games

Format

Teams in MP and WP will play a home and away season.

Promotion and Relegation

The bottom two (2) teams in Premier will be relegated to C1 division in the subsequent season (2026).

The top two (2) teams in C1 will be promoted to the Premier division the subsequent season (2026).

Should a spot in a Premier division open (e.g., where it is known that a team is not returning to the Premier division in 2026), the spot will be offered to teams using the following based on where they finished in 2025:

- 1. The team that finishes 3rd in the C1 division
- 2. If declined, the team that finishes second-last in the 2025 Premier division
- 3. If declined, it will be offered to the last place Premier team
- 4. If declined, the spot will continue to be offered to the next highest team in line from the C1 division until accepted. Teams may only be promoted to the Premier division if they finish within six points of the second place C1 team. All promotions to the MP and WP divisions must be approved by Ontario Soccer.

MC4

Teams in MC4 will play each team once. After that, each team will receive two playoff games. The top four (1st to 4th) teams in league play will participate in the championship playoff. The next four (5th to 8th) will play in the consolation playoff. The bottom three (9th to 11th) will play a game against each of the other two teams for the wooden spoon. As follows:

• Semifinal #1: 1st v 4th

• Semifinal #2: 2nd v 3rd

• 3rd Place: Semifinal losers

• Final: Semifinal winners

MC4 Consolation Playoff

• Semifinal #1: 5th v 8th

• Semifinal #2: 6th v 7th

• 3rd Place (7th Place overall): Semifinal losers

• Final (5th Place overall): Semifinal winners

• 9th v 10th

• 9th v 11th

• 10th v 11th

First Stage

In the first stage, teams will be divided into two divisions: U21 Premier East and U21 Premier West. Each division will have nine teams. Each team will play each of the opponents in their division once (8-games). Where teams finish in the first stage determines where they play in the second stage.

Second Stage

Teams will be placed into groups of six for the second stage. Here is where each team will be placed based on where they finish in the first stage:

- 1st, 2nd and 3rd in U21 Premier East and 1st, 2nd and 3rd in U21 Premier West → Promotion Group
- 4th, 5th and 6th in U21 Premier East and 4th, 5th, and 6th in U21 Premier West → Second Group
- 7th, 8th and 9th in U21 Premier East and 7th, 8th and 9th in U21 Premier West → Relegation Group

Each team will play each of the opponents in their group once (5-games).

There will be two stages.

First Stage

Teams in WC2 will play each team once in the first stage of the season (9-games). Where teams finish in the first stage determines where they play in the second stage

Second Stage

Teams will be placed into a group of five for the second stage. Here is where each team will be placed based on where they finish in the first stage:

- 1^{st} through $5^{th} \rightarrow Promotion Group$
- 6^{th} through $10^{th} \rightarrow \text{Relegation Group}$

Each team will play a round robin against the each of the other four teams in their group (4-games). The bottom five will play a round robin against the each of the other four teams in their group (4-games).

The winner of the MC4 league will be offered promotion to MC3. The winner of the Championship playoff will be offered promotion. If the league winner and playoff winner are the same team, the team that finishes 2nd in league play will be promoted.

OPEN SPOTS IN ANY COMPETITIVE DIVISION

Should a spot in a competitive division open (e.g., where it is known that a club with an existing spot is not returning in 2026), the spot will be offered to teams using the following based on where they finished in 2025:

- 1. The team that finishes 3rd in the next lowest division
- 2. If declined, the team that finishes second-last in that division in 2025
- 3. If declined, it will be offered to the last place team in 2025
- 4. If declined, the spot will continue to be offered to the next highest team in line from the next lowest division until accepted.

Format

All divisions will play 14 games in the league, except for WR4, MOT4 and OT1/2 who will have a second phase/playoff.

WR4

There will be two stages.

First Stage

Teams in WR4 will play each team once in the first stage of the season (11-games). Where teams finish in the first stage determines where they play in the second stage

Second Stage

Teams will be placed into a group of four for the second stage. Here is where each team will be placed based on where they finish in the first stage:

- 1^{st} through $4^{th} \rightarrow$ First Tier
- 5^{th} through $8^{th} \rightarrow Second Tier$
- 9^{th} through $12^{th} \rightarrow$ Third Tier

Each team will play a round robin against the each of the other three teams in their group (3-games)

MOT4

There will be two stages.

First Stage

Teams in MOT4 will play each team once in the first stage of the season (10-games). Where teams finish in the first stage determines where they play in the second stage

Second Stage

Teams will be placed into one of two groups for the second stage. Here is where each team will be placed based on where they finish in the first stage:

- 1^{st} through $6^{th} \rightarrow Promotion Group$
- 7^{th} through $11^{th} \rightarrow Second Tier$

Each team will play a round robin against the each of the other 4-5 teams in their group (4-5-games)

OT1/2

Each team will play each of the opponents in their division once (13-games).

Each team will get an additional playoff game. Here is who each team will play based off of where they finish:

- 1st vs 2nd
- 3rd vs 4th
- 5th v 6th
- 7th v 8th
- 9th v 10th
- 11th v 12th
- 13th v 14th

Promotion, Relegation & New Team Placement

MR & WR

Teams that finish top two (2) are eligible for promotion. Recreational teams can decline promotion – except in cases where a team finishes first (in the same division) in consecutive seasons, the LMB has the authority to move the team in question to the next highest division.

Teams that finish bottom two in a division for the 2025 season will only be relegated for the subsequent season if divisions need to be balanced.

New teams may request to play in any division. If there is space in the division, they will be placed there. If there isn't, they will be offered a spot in a different division. The LMB will review new team applications on April 23 and inform clubs which division their team is being offered a spot in by April 29.

OT & MOT

The first-place team in each division will be promoted to the next highest division for the subsequent season (2026). OT & MOT teams <u>cannot</u> decline promotion.

The last place team in each division will be relegated to the next lowest division for the subsequent season (2026).

Should a spot open in a division, it will be offered to the second-place team of the next lowest division from the 2025 season, provided they finished within 6 points of the first-place team. If the team declines promotion, it will be offered to 3rd place team from said division.
